- "Nuestro Laredo" showcases Laredo families enjoying nature
- "Our Story is Our Power" pays homage to the history of the Gateway City



## HISTORIC LAREDO WALKING TOUR

This is the perfect way to get a glimpse into our story and discover the history and agricultural heritage of this 269-year-old city that has lived under seven flags. Conducted in English and Spanish, the tour showcases spots like the Republic of the Rio Grande Museum, the Villa Antigua Border Heritage Museum, San Agustin Cathedral, San Agustin Plaza, and Casa Ortiz. Tickets and maps available at the Webb County Heritage Foundation located inside the Villa Antigua Border Heritage Museum.

## HAUNTED HERITAGE SAN AGUSTIN GHOST WALK TOUR (SELF-GUIDED)

Created by the Webb County Heritage Foundation, this tour presents some of Laredo's most notorious haunted sites and recounts tales of apparitions and other strange phenomena in residential and commercial buildings throughout the historic district. The self-guided tour can be accessed using a mobile phone and there's a map to indicate the various stops on the tour. *Maps available at the Webb County Heritage Foundation located inside the Villa Antigua Border Heritage Museum.*



# THE PAST COMES ALIVE IN OUR HISTORIC DISTRICTS



“The Streets of Laredo” is more than just a well-known song. These streets tell our history. For centuries, Laredoans both famous and infamous have walked up and down our avenues. Pioneers, conquistadors, artists, and countless others have visited or called this place home, and now it’s your turn to explore this hallowed ground.







### SAN AGUSTIN HISTORIC DISTRICT

Founded by Tomas Sanchez in 1755, the San Agustin Historic District is the oldest section of Laredo and is brimming with worthwhile tourist stops, noteworthy museums, historical landmarks, and renowned architecture. The anchor icon of the district today is the towering spire of San Agustin Cathedral overlooking a picturesque plaza of the same name, San Agustin Plaza.

### SAN BERNARDO AVENUE

Spanning 40+ city blocks in Laredo's Cultural District, this is where the real treasure awaits. San Bernardo Avenue is lined with eclectic import shops and authentic Mexican goods ranging from pottery and art pieces to jewelry, leather goods, home décor, and more. Here you'll find authentic Mexican cafes and food trucks alongside vintage motels.







## **LAREDO CULTURAL DISTRICT**

The Laredo Cultural District seeks to celebrate our rich traditions by uniting creative minds. People gather here to restore and embrace Laredo's unique cultural heritage while supporting the revitalization and growth of our historic, cultural, and creative assets.

## **FORT MCINTOSH**

Take the trolley or drive across the train bridge to Fort McIntosh, which encompasses a nationally recognized historic district and was also a former Army base that's now home to Laredo College.

## **OLD MERCADO**

Laredo began to expand northward from San Agustin Plaza following the erection of a new City Hall from 1883-1884. The City Hall area was known as El Mercado as its rear portion housed stalls for vendors. The feature structure of this district houses the Laredo Center for the Arts and the Webb County Heritage Foundation today.

## **ST. PETER'S HISTORIC DISTRICT**

Bounded by Santa Maria Ave., the Texas-Mexican tracks, the Missouri-Pacific tracks, and Hidalgo Street on the south, the St. Peter's neighborhood was developed between 1881 and World War I and was named for St. Peter's Church. The church was Laredo's second Catholic Church and the first for English speakers. Many of the homes and the church structure remain in working condition today.

## **EL AZTECA LOCAL HISTORIC DISTRICT**

This predominantly residential neighborhood was established from 1870-1940. Of note are the frequency of Mexican vernacular architectural style homes and structures. Interrupted by progress, a major disruption to the area came about with the development of Interstate Highway 35 in the 1960s and the neighborhood was bisected to install roadway infrastructure.

# OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES



## BIRDING TRAILS

Laredo is home to hundreds of species of local and migratory birds. Here's a listing of popular birding trails in the area:

### The Chacon Creek Trail

Access this trail via the Benavides Softball Complex, Dryden Park or the Garcia Vela Little League Field.

### Lake Casa Blanca

#### International State Park

The lake wetlands provide habitat for wintering ducks and shorebirds as well as Osprey and American White Pelicans.

### Las Palmas Trail

This trail begins east of International Bridge II and extends for a half-mile along the Rio Grande.

### North Central Park

This park has asphalted trails which wind around a beaver pond and boast some of the best wildlife views in the city.

### Paso del Indio Trail

This trail stretches a mile long behind the river road of the Lamar Bruni Vergara Environmental Science Center.

### Ranchito Road

Adjoining Lake Casa Blanca International State Park and runs between a lagoon and wetland.

### Robert Muller Trails

This trail is located in northwest Laredo and can be accessed at the end of Atlanta Drive.

## St. Peter's Square

Found in the historic district of Saint Peter's Plaza, this square is home to green parakeets roosting in old buildings.

## Zacate Creek Trails

Visitors can access the trails along the banks of the creek or at the following parks: Seven Flags, Eistetter, Taylor and Cecilia Moreno.

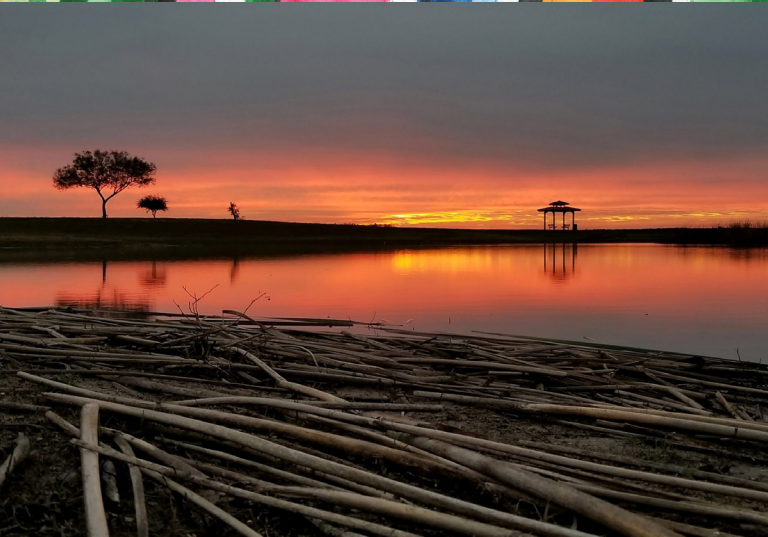

Attendees will have the opportunity to deepen their avian knowledge of South Texas and explore along Laredo's riverfront, creek systems, nature trails, and private ranchland, some of which provide sites that have never been birded before.

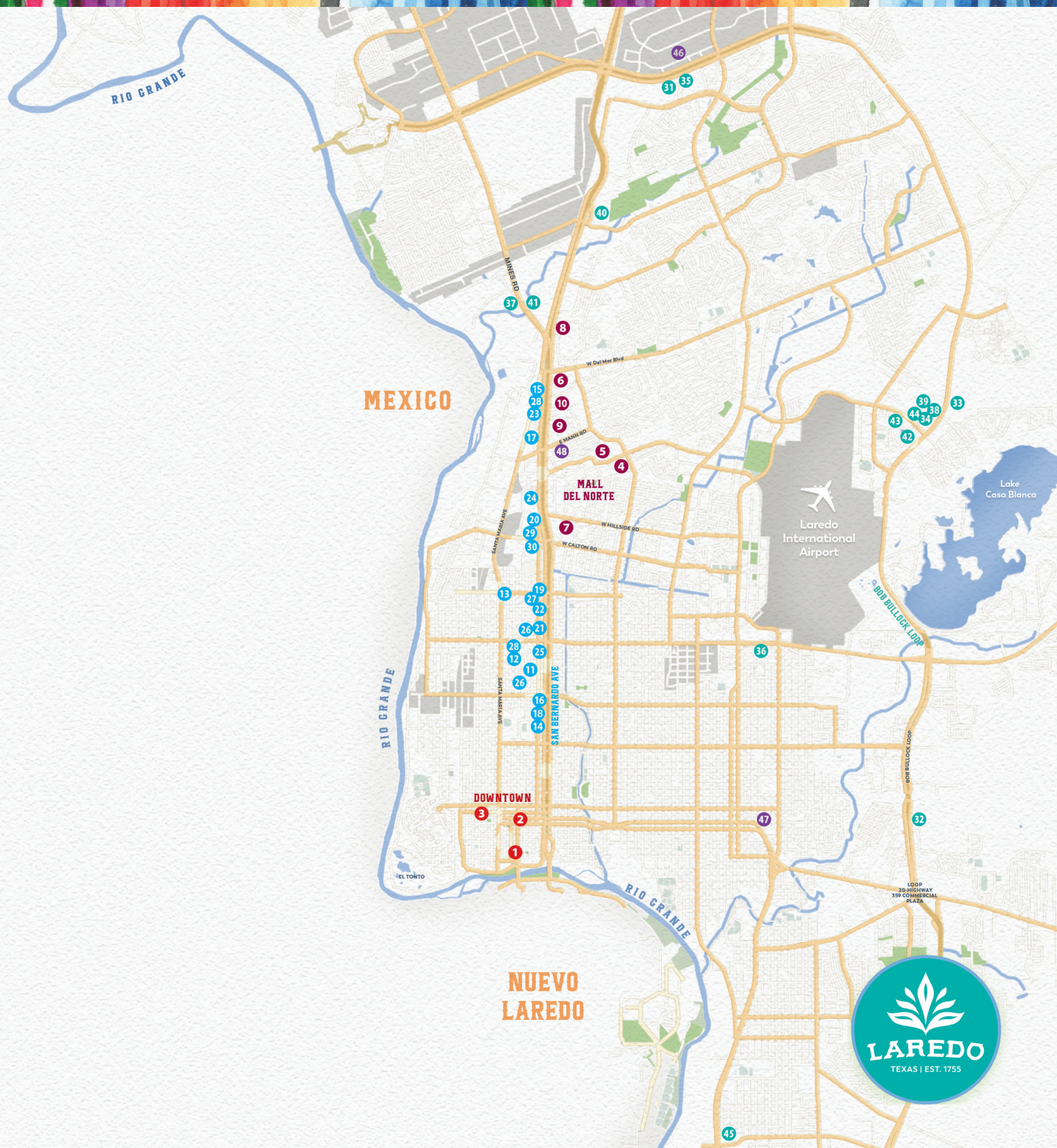
